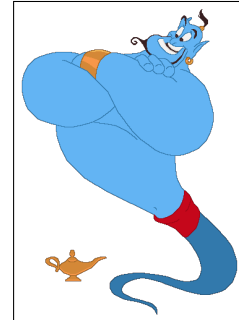


Research Personnel
